Early College and Career Opportunities at SEZP High Schools

Starting in fall 2023, high schools in SEZP will be the **only schools in Springfield Public Schools to offer an early college experience** for all students. Every student can take courses aligned to specific career pathways and earn college credit.

SEZP high schools are committed to providing students with a clear path to financial independence and exciting, high-paying, high-growth careers. Students have the opportunity to:

- ✓ Develop skills for the **highest-paying career industries** in the region
- ✓ Obtain **certifications** to enter the workforce upon graduation or pursue college
- ✓ Earn compensation through internships & work-based learning placements
- Defer graduation for a fifth year & complete a fully-funded Associate's degree alongside their HS diploma

SEZP offers **4 wall-to-wall early college high schools** that provide all students the opportunity to earn three to six college credits per semester, beginning in their freshman year. Students take classes with high school peers and transition onto college campuses when ready.
